

WHAT CAN I DO WITH MY BULK HARD WASTE

WHEN THERE IS NO COLLECTION?

Bulk hard waste collection happens every second year, with the next service scheduled in 2023. Ratepayers receive an extra waste pass in years where there is no bulk collection. If you have unwanted bulky items that can't wait until next year, here are some options:

- Drop items suitable for reuse at Fossicker's Tip Shop. Fossicker's accepts (subject to operational requirements) goods in reasonable condition for resale such as furniture and household items; homewares; some electrical goods; toys; outdoor and garden items; DIY and renovation goods. (You can also drop off unwanted TVs, computers, printers and gas bottles).
- List items on Facebook groups such as Pay It Forward Albany & Surrounds and Albany Buy & Sell, or websites such as Freecycle and Gumtree.
- Organise a skip bin or collection from a local provider.
- Remember, when buying new bulky items to ask retailers if they will take your old items for recycling or disposal.
- If items are not suitable for reuse or recycling, you can dispose of them at the Hanrahan Road Waste Facility. Waste passes accepted here, though fees may apply for some items).
