VOLUNTEERS

Brendan and the emergency management team oversee more than 700 volunteer members across 16 Albany brigades. In the event of an emergency, Brendan and his team work with the highly skilled volunteers to combat fires safely and effectively.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

Brendan and our emergency management team work closely with other agencies on the Local Emergency Management Committee to ensure Albany is ready in the event of a flood, fire or earthquake. The team are continually reviewing and amending our emergency management to ensure we're prepared.

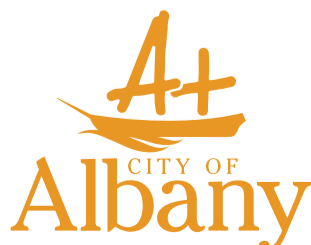
COMMUNITY SAFETY
